Edmonds delves intimately into the emotional, spiritual, physical, and relationship aspects of the disease and shares candidly the choices, experiences, and lessons learned. The book includes an in-a-nutshell practical guide for caregivers with limited time.

A popular speaker, Edmonds' audiences include Alzheimer's groups, churches, civic groups, grief organizations, medical professionals, senior seminars, and public awareness events.
